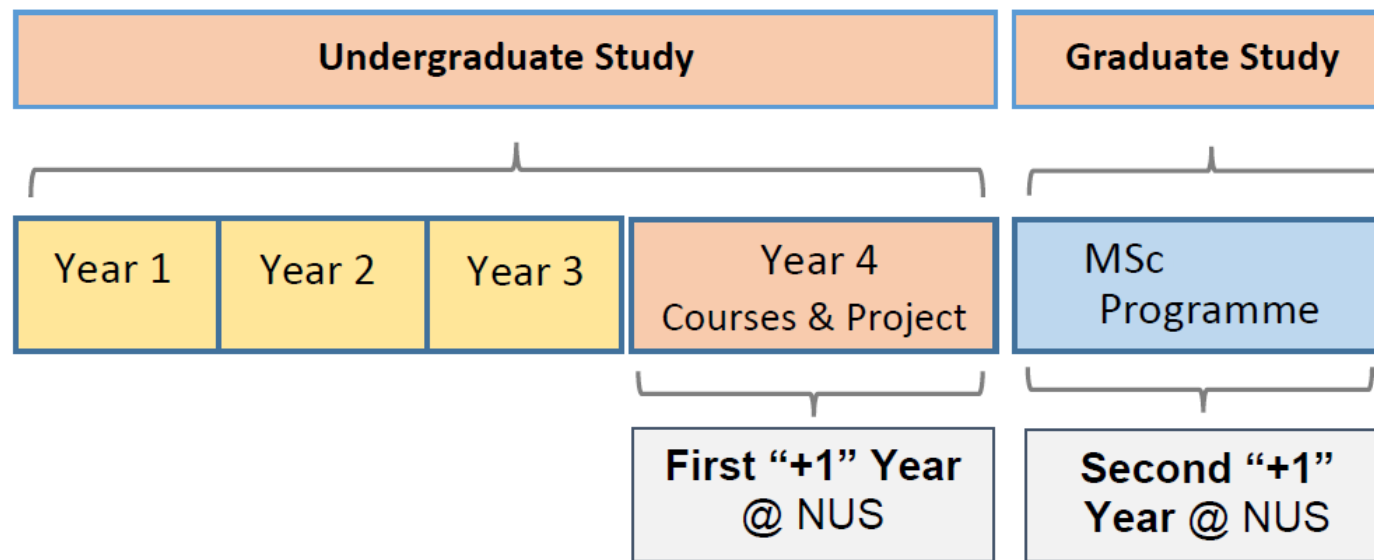
Overseas experience in a familiar environment

- Exposure to a different study environment
- Work with quality professors in a top university
- Network with future international colleagues
- Get an NUS MSc degree (coursework)



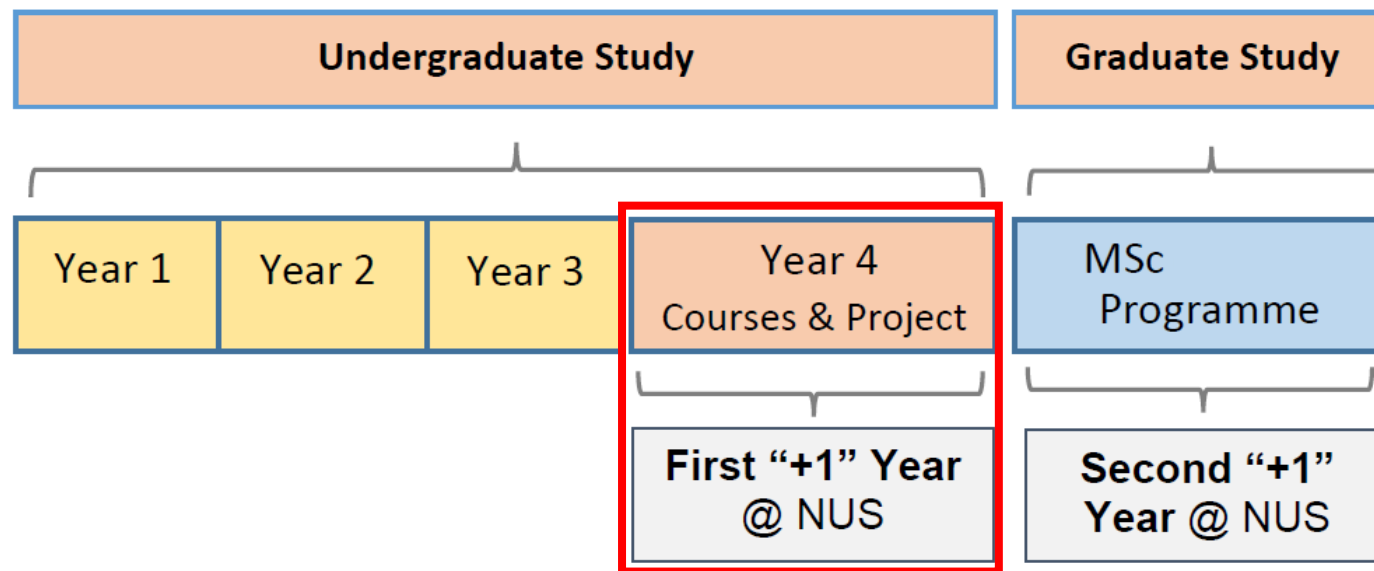
Year 3 candidates from Partner University

- Good academic standing
- Meet NUS English requirement (IELTS > 6.0 or TOEFL > 85)
- Pass interview by NUS panel



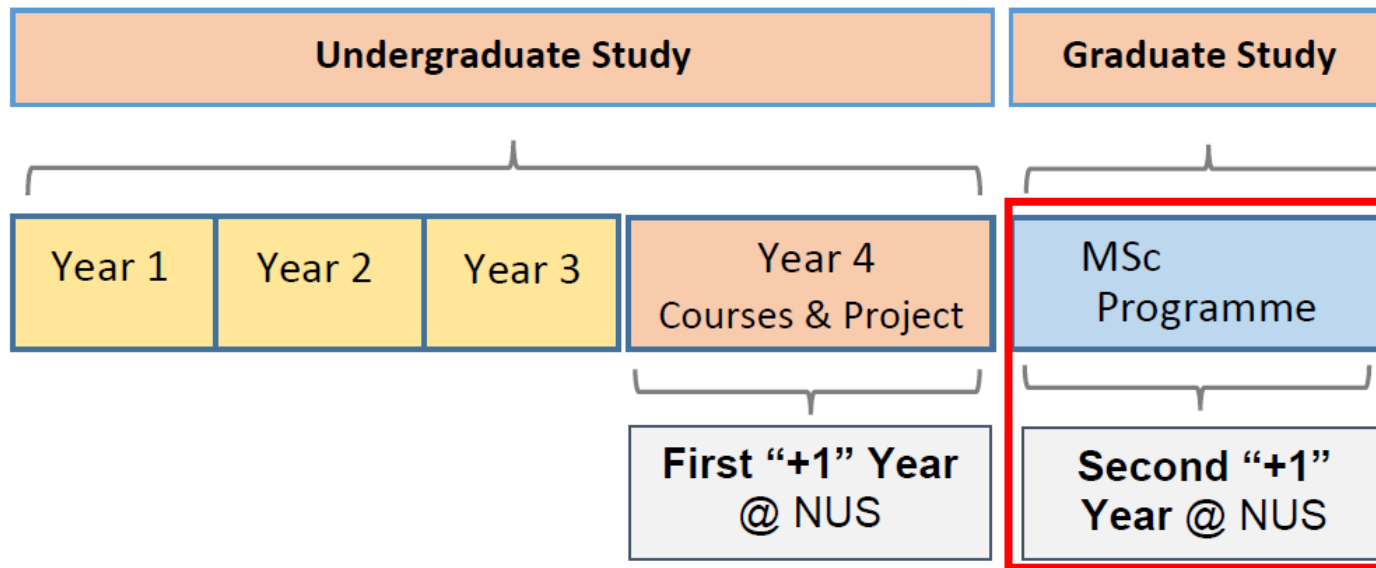
First +1 year at NUS

- At least 16 modular credits (MCs) of graduate modules. Typically, a coursework module has 4MCs.
- Final Year Project (FYP). Workload equivalent to 8MCs.
- If FYP is not required by Partner University, it can be replaced with 2 coursework modules (each 4MCs).
- Coursework modules & FYP to fulfil the graduation requirements of Partner University
- **No Joint Degree**



First +1 year at NUS (Semester II)

- Apply for admission to MSc in Jan
- Provisional admission, pending
 - Graduation from Partner University with good standing
 - Complete Final Year Project (or another 8MCs of coursework modules)
 - Completion of at least 16MCs of coursework modules in NUS with a minimum CAP of 3.50



Second +1 year at NUS for 311-MSc (coursework)

- Standard graduation requirements: 10 modules
- 311-MSc: Transfer up to two coursework modules (8MCs) taken in first +1 year to MSc
- Complete eight more course modules to graduate (32MCs)
- More feasible to complete MSc within a year with the transfer of modules from first +1

Fees

Second +1 year

- Standard MSc programme fees: S\$46,000 (40MCs)
- 311-MSc: **pro-rated** programme fee taking into account the credit transfers
- For example, a 311-MSc student credit transfers 8MCs from first +1 to MSc
 - Pro-rated MSc programme fee payable is 80% of standard fees.

Expenses

- Accommodation + Food + Transportation = ~ **S\$1,200 – S\$1,500** per month

新加坡留学一个月的生活费用：

- 1.首先在外留学，我们要解决的就是自己的**住宿**问题。在新加坡留学是可以选择学生公寓和政府提供的租屋。宿舍公寓一般是两人间或者三人间，费用大约在900元新币到1500元新币之间。而政府提供的公寓一般是2室1厅，或者是3室1厅。不包括水电费的情况下，**一个月大约在500-800元新币**。
- 2.其次要解决的就是自己的**伙食**问题。新加坡留学生的伙食，一份大约在3-5元新币。学生每天花费的饮食费用在12元新币左右，**一个月在饮食上面花费的费用在400元新币左右**。
- 3.然后就是**交通**上面的问题，上学是可以乘坐巴士或地铁的，每趟基本上为0.8-3元新币左右。一个月的消费在100元至150元新币左右。政府为留学生在交通上面还提供了优惠政策，所以一个月**大约在100元新币左右**。
- 4.按照上面的比例来进行计算，**一年下来在生活费用上面的支出大约在5万至6万人民币**。

Jan - May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Semester II Students apply for admission to MSc in late Jan. Will be given provisional admission, pending graduation from partner university, and meeting the 311 program continuation requirements. Admission to MSc to be confirmed in May.
Second +1 in NUS	
Aug - May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To meet prevailing graduation requirements for NUS MSc degree.
